

Costs

Way back, even before we realized that God was leading us into a long-term ministry, we felt led to avoid letting the financial end of things become a goal or a hindrance when deciding where to participate. To this day, we've never set a fee for what we do and have always had our needs met, never taking for granted the freedom we enjoy without the pressure to 'make money'. Of course, where there are travel expenses, we do ask that they be covered (i.e. flights or mileage) but anything in the way of an honorarium is strictly up to the host church or committee.

A/V Requirements

We typically bring our own headset mics, receivers, keyboard and music stand along if at all possible – we're familiar with this gear and it serves our purposes well. We also have our own laptop with projection software to display lyrics since our ministry is intended for group participation (we occasionally do 'special music'). If, for any reason, we are unable to bring along the above items, we ask that a reasonable effort be made to ensure that the keyboard or piano (recently tuned, please), sound and projection systems that you provide be dependable and suitable for the venue size.

Accommodations

If the event involved requires that we spend an overnight or a weekend, we ask to be billeted with a church family rather than being put in a hotel room. Not only is this less expensive for the organizing party, but we gain the wonderful opportunity of meeting some new people and, through them, getting to know a lot more about the area and the local church. We count the friendships we've made while staying with folks to rank among the best perks of doing ministry on-the-road. The only 'special request' we have is that we get two separate beds. Thanks!
